RELEVANT SECTIONS OF THE BES ARTICLE OF ASSOCIATION:

ARTICLE II: PURPOSES

Section 1. Purposes. The purposes of this Society are to:

- Promote scientific and educational purposes, in connection with the science and practice of evaluation.
- Improve evaluation theory, practice and methods; increase evaluation use; promote evaluation as a profession; and support the contribution of evaluation to the generation of theory and knowledge about effective human action.
- Engage in a diversity of activities and enter into, perform, and carry out contracts of any kind necessary or convenient to, or incidental to, the accomplishment of any one or more of the non-profit purposes of the Society.

Section 2. Non-Profit Character. The Society is a not for-profit, non-political organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes.

ARTICLE III: MANDATES

For achieving the above objectives, the Society may do any or all of the following:

- Accept donations, gifts, contributions or subscriptions, in cash or in kind from individuals, institutions or companies. Foreign donations may be accepted after complying with laws and rules of the government regulating such matters.
- Hold, acquire, purchase, hire, lease or sell any moveable or immovable property and also invest money or property of the Society upon such security and in such manner as may be determined by the Society.
- Borrow or raise any money required for the Society upon such terms and in such manner as may be determined by the Society.
- File, prosecute, defend, compromise or refer to arbitration any suit or legal proceeding for or against the Society.
- Enter into any arrangement or agreement with any government department or authority (national, local or municipal), public or quasi-public bodies or bilateral and multilateral foreign donor agency in the interest of the Society.

Membership: Section 2 (Article of Association). *Society's Membership.*

Life Member: A general member who has substantially contributed to the mission and cause of evaluation Society will be considered as Life Member by the Executive Board. Life members must make a donation to the Society to be determined by the Executive Board.

General Member. An individual desiring to join this Society may ask for consideration by making a written application including the appropriate fee. Individual membership will be determined by substantial involvement, contribution and commitment to the cause of evaluation as individual, commissioners and policymaker which will be determined by Executive Board.

Associate Member. An individual desiring to join this Society may ask for consideration by making a written application including the appropriate fee. Associate membership will be determined by substantial involvement contribution and commitment to the cause of evaluation as individual, commissioners and policymaker which will be determined by Executive Board. *Associate Member* will enjoy all the privilege of General Members, may be invited to participate in the meeting of the Society but shall not have right to vote.

Institutional Member. With the approval of the Executive Board, an institution subscribing to the ideas of the Society can become an Institutional Member by making an contribution towards the Society. An institutional Members may be invited to participate in the meeting of the Society but shall not have right to vote.

Distinguished Member. A person having academic excellence and spare of policy influence to the cause of promoting knowledge and practice of evaluation may be awarded as Distinguish Member. Distinguish Members shall not have any voting right.
